Portion of CDBG Funds Allocated to Homeless Programs

Each year funding is provided to local jurisdictions by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. These funds may be used for social services, economic development programs, capital projects, and housing projects that assist low and moderate income households or aid in the elimination of blight. Of the \$37.7 million in total CDBG funds allocated within the region this year, 5.2 percent is earmarked for homeless-related facilities and services.
