GENERAL INFORMATION

- HUD National Competition for CoC Homeless Funds
- Funds projects <u>dedicated</u> to serving homeless persons
- Requires local review, rating, and ranking of ALL projects
- Selected projects submitted to HUD Competition by a Lead Agency, "Collaborative Applicant"

NATIONAL APPLICATION

HUD National Application has 3 major parts:

- CoC System-wide Application ('Exhibit 1')
- A Project Priority List including funding amounts
- All Project Level applications approved in the local process ('Project Application)

FUNDING LEVELS

- CoC formula based on geography and amount needed to fund renewals - \$19.5 million
- Divided into 2 "Tiers" \$18,334,045 and \$1,170,258
- Bonus: High-scoring CoC (Exhibit 1) applications 10% of geography funds Approx. \$1.5 million
- Traditional Bonus amount TBD up to 6% of ARD
- CoC Planning Grant funds \$585,129 RTFH only

PROGRAM FUNDING TYPES

- Renewal Grant Inventory Worksheet
 2018: Transition & Consolidated Grants
- New PSH, RRH, and Expansion Projects
- Bonus 2018: Domestic Violence TH& RRH, DV Coordinated Entry
- CoC Planning Grant, HMIS, CES

PROJECT APPLICATION PROCESS

- Local Process:
 - File Intent to Submit
 - Provide Eligibility Documents
 - Prepare Project Application (Exhibit 2)
 - Follow Instructions for entering local process
 - Receive local score and decision
 - Finalize your project in the HUD e-snaps system

TYPES OF PROJECTS

- PH PSH: Permanent Supportive Housing long term housing and support services for persons with disabilities – new or renewal
- PH-RRH: Rapid rehousing Time limited rental assistance and case management
- Joint TH- RRH renewal or new Transitional grantoffers transitional housing and rapid rehousing in the same project
- Transitional Housing or Safe Haven renewals only
- Expansion Extend housing, operations, and services to existing projects

REQUIREMENTS

- Only 501 (c) 3 or units of government can apply
- Active DUNS number
- Registered in SAMS Grant management system
- Commit to participate in HMIS data base (DV dedicated programs use alternate data base)
- Commit to participating in Coordinated Entry System (CES) for referrals
- Must provide 25% project match

TIMELINE

- Many Steps
- Local Process must complete key milestones set by HUD
- Step 1: Complete Intent to Submit Forms by July 13th
- Priorities Decided by Board July 19th
- TIMELINE on RTFHSD.Org Website
- Forms, notices, important instructions on website
- New Applicants Contact Technical Assistance
