1	Tool Customization	How will the tool be customized locally? What percentages and ranking priorities will the CoC use? Will areas rated in prior years t appearing on the tool continue to be used?	Please solicit provider input and clarify	The committee is currently soliciting provider feedback. Please review the thresholds, benchmarks and points on each of the spreadsheets in the tool prior to the special meeting on May 31st.
2	HIC as a Main Data Source	HIC appears to be the main data source, but not all projects are listed on the HIC (i.e. Operations grants).	Make sure CoC rates against the GIW or alternate source for applicable programs.	HUD tool draws certain information from the HIC, other sources of data (such as APR, applications, systems reports) are also "Tool Resources". Support services and operations only programs will draw appropriate data from alternate sources
3	"Chronically Homeless" Definition	"chronically homeless" definition is pulled from APR 26a, meaning this is only the current definition. Will negatively impact projects serving those under previous definitions.	Ensure scoring is adjusted/ points or percentages reduced to not overly penalize providers who have operated thru definition changes	Rating and Review has access to reports dated 10.1.16 through 9.30.17 and 1.01.17 through 12.31.17. We will confirm if records from the prior period are based on the prior CH definition.
4	% entering housing without any income	There is now a "minimum percentage of those who entered without income" expectation (HUD suggests 80%). What % will the CoC use? This is a new criteria that providers were not informed of in advance, leaving no opportunity to adjust accordingly. Also, programs have no control over the income levels of persons entering the program (VISPDAT score only) and so are being rated on something they cannot influence.	Eliminate this criteria if possible. If this is a required field, then reduce the expected % of a very low number and increase in future years if needed.	HUD's intent is to serve eligible persons, including who enter without income. Allowing entry of persons without income was criteria in one of the questions in the 2017 Project Application for both renewal and new projects. The benchmark and associated points can be adjusted at the local level. R & R will examine actual performance data as part of establishing recommended benchmarks.
5	% entering housing from places not meant for human habitation.	There is now a "minimum percentage of those who entered from places not meant for human habitation". HUD suggests 50%. Emergency Shelter and Safehaven are not included but are eligible stays under the CH definition. This is a new criteria that providers were not informed of in advance, leaving no opportunity to adjust accordingly. Also, programs have little control over the prior stay of persons entering the program and so are being rated on something they cannot influence. Most MHSA-funded programs put their clients in Emergency Shelter prior to placement in PSH due to Housing First. Also, HMIS Reports historically only show the stay "the night before" housing and not a complete history (person may have been on streets for years). Also, the city is increasing using large tents to serve the homeless, so this practice is at odds with this scoring area.	Eliminate this criteria if possible. If this is a required field, then reduce the expected % of a very low number and increase in future years if needed.	The HUD 2016 and 2017 project level applications included a question (ex:3B 5a in new) about 'quickly moving' people from the street to permanent housing - one of the conditons was that there was to not use intermediary programs (like emergency shelter or transitional housing). Most programs that responded that the met the rapid movement criteria. Matching funds (such as MHSA or state funding) with CoC funding does create challenges. HUD CoC is focused on their program intents for the use of the CoC competitive funds. HUD's other resources such as ESG, CDBG are better designed to support projects using shelter.
6	"Returns to Homelessness"	We will now be rated on "percentage returning to homelessness within 12 months of exit". Expectation seems to be 15% or less. Projects have no control over this outcome once persons leave a program. Given HMIS issues with duplicate entries, how will this be measured and can RTFH reports be relied on to be accurate? Is this measured just by "touching the system"?	Eliminate this criteria if possible. If this is a required field, then reduce the expected % of a very low number and increase in future years if needed.	This is a HUD Systems Performance requirement, introduced as part of the 'Big 7' in 2015 and is part of what HUD judges the CoC Application on. With the 'opening' of the HMIS system in 2017, the data is more available than in past years. The systems performance measure report gives information about exit from PH and reentry to housing components of the system. Touching the system for support services only (such as food, transportation, counseling) are not included. The CoC System level data for CoC-funded programs is separated into six month segments which allows for potential evaluation under varying conditions. The data is based on client-level data and is captured by number of days between exit from PH to return to housing system. The systems level report for the overall CoC for persons exiting PH within 12 months falls within the 15% or less threshold.
7	Increasing Income	A new expectation of "8% of stayers and leavers in PSH will <u>increase or gain new</u> Earned Income" will be implemented. Projects have no time to adjust to this new requirement, as the previous measurement included "maintaining" income.	Eliminate this criteria if possible. If this is a required field, then reduce the expected % of a very low number and increase in future years if needed.	The 2017 project level application (4A 3a) asked projects about <i>increasing</i> income for participants. HUD rates the CoC overall application on the increase as well. The 8% and 10% levels are relatively low given the agency commitment. R & R is currently looking at actual local outcome data on each of the System Performance measures in comparison with the HUD standard and could

Item #	Area	Concern/ Reasoning/ Impact from 2017 Cycle	Suggestion	Initial Response (DRAFT)
1	RTFH Custom reports used in the 2017 cycle were inaccurate and/ or incongruent.	For one PSH renewal, the report used in scoring showed 2 of 3 entries were within the timeliness standard and a CoC APR for the same period shows all were within the standard (incongruent). Scoring should be aware that some changes within HMIS to clean up data quality will result in the timeliness measure reflecting as not meeting the standard.	Ensure integrity of any reports or tools used to rate programs, that they measure what they state they measure.	Data integrity is important to the CoC. The current process rewards accuracy and timeliness at the point of initial data entry . Records involving data cleanup are recorded at the earliest point that the data is accurately entered.
		The "RTFH Custom Report" was not congruent, showing that (for example) 2 of 22 served had homeless histories exceeding 6 months and also stating that 18 of 22 met the (current) CH definition.		The RTFH Custom report could be reconsidered or replaced with HUD standardized reports such as system performance measures or APR items. The HUD Project Level Performance report looks at the proportion of persons entering from 'unsheltered' or street status.
		-The report measures "histories exceeding 6 months" from an incorrect data source. Confirmed in an email from Pat Leslie that the RTFH report pulls this information from "approximate date homelessness started" field from the entry/ exit. In judging #13 "# of persons with prior length of homelessness over 6 months", this data source measures the <u>most recent episode of homelessness</u> , not total history. Thus, another data source is needed or points reallocated to reflect the actual data being measured.		Please see other responses in this category. The HUD systems Performance Measures report looks at time in homelessness using two data points: the entry-exit and bed nights information and the client's Living Situation (Data Standards element 3.917) response as well as time spent in permanent housing projects between Project Start and Housing Move-In. This information is added to the client's entry date, effectively extending the client's entry date backward in time. This "adjusted entry date" is then used in the calculations just as if it were the client's actual entry date. This is a FY2017 change in how HUD calculates the length of time homeless. (as opposed to the length of stay).
2	RTFH custom report and HUD standardized tool only measure the current "chronically homeless" definition (i.e. Q11).	long standing programs serving under many tenants under previous definitions are disadvantaged, penalized.	Points should be awarded for those who met previous definitions or available points for this item should be reduced if only the current CH definition is eligible	HUD's chronic definition has changed on three occasions over the past decade. Each change advantages / disadvantages various programs. Formal HUD reports capture the most recent definition. Points allocation could be considered in the local customization process.
3	Chronic Health Conditions and Physical Disabilities to "high needs populations" scoring.	Such conditions result in additional vulnerability pre-housing and intensive service needs post- housing including delays in establishing earned income. Applicability is unclear in 2018 given the new HUD Tool	We recommend adding Chronic Health Conditions and Physical Disabilities to "high needs populations" scoring.	Health conditions were included as part of the acuity measure in prior tools. This item can be considered for local customization of the tool.
4	"Change in Length of Stay"	It should be noted that this area negatively impacts newer projects as they lease up and operate initial terms of programs, building participant housing stability. Also, the goal of PSH is to build long-term participant housing stability and with 3% regional vacancy rates, many PSH programs are "bottle-necked". Applicable with new HUD Tool	Adjust scoring / points allocation to not overly penalize programs in this area	Newer programs have historically been included in Tier 1 as a special category of projects that have "served less than one year" by the rating and ranking data catchment period using the project operating dates. This allows projects time to lease up, begin, and complete a full year of operations prior to the standard renewal rating. This practice can be reviewed as use of the HUD tool is implemented,
5	"Resource Utilization"	It was positive that the tool last year averaged 4 dates throughout the year (previous versions took one date). Scoring should use caution when judging utilization based off of beds noted on the HIC due to fluctuations, dynamics with family and mixed programs.	Consider keeping this for the 2018 cycle, if applicable.	Quarterly occupancy was introduced to strengthen assessment in 2017. Continued use can be considered for 2018.
6	Appeals procedure and process	Appeals should include the ability to appeal based on verified errors in data sources pulled automatically by scoring or RTFH. Respecting the need for timeliness, appeals should not be capped at 3 items when more than 3 are valid. Some agencies lost as much as 14 points based on inaccurate data sources pulled by RTFH and scoring. Appeals were denied based on refusal to investigate individual client files and in the future scoring should allow time for detailed review.	Please implement for the 2018 cycle	The HUD tool uses data generated by standardized reports in the HUD system which includes data from HIC, HMIS. 11	Rating and Ranking Results	We recommend that the Initial and Final Rating and Ranking document for each competition clearly and specifically show to the untrained eye which projects are renewals, reallocations, or new projects. These documents should also clearly show where Tier 1 ends and Tier 2 begins. This information is needed to show the net loss/gain/ reallocation with in the CoC. In addition, any developer attempting to develop new dedicated projects needs to show (and calm fears) about the security of the operational subsidy, the local process, and the degree of risk to the subsidy to investors, banks, and other funding sources.	Consider adjusting for the 2018 cycle	Designation of project applications as renewal, new, expansion, less than one year, planning, or non-housing (HMIS, CES, Planning) can readily be included in documentation. The final ranking report can indicate where the Tier 1 / Tier 2 mark and straddle are projected to occur (subject to HUD alteration).
12	CoC Project Ranking Strategy	In 2017, The scoring process used a tool for each program type and considered them to be equivalent so that a score of 165 on one tool is ranked comparably to a 165 on another tool. Projects were then placed in order of numeric score into Tiers 1 and 2. This practice results in PSH renewals being ranked as equivalent to TH renewals, new projects, reallocated TH projects, RRH, etc. This practice puts PSH renewals (who have spent +/- 4-5 years developing a property and have brought into the CoC leveraged funds from other sources that have 15-55 year commitments) at a higher degree of risk because they are ranked by score with other program types. This practice puts TH renewals on par with PSH renewals, which does not reflect HUD priorities or the CoC's needs.	Given HUD's focus and the region's need for permanent units, a more effective ranking practice would utilize the following (or similar) strategy: prioritize PSH renewals first in Tier 1, RRH renewals second, reallocated TH programs, TH renewals, then new projects and planning grants at the bottom (or a similar approach). This would add a degree of certainty to PSH and RRH programs that maintain the gains of previous competitions while still incentivizing performance. It would also assist PSH developers to utilize CoC funds in their development portfolios.	The 2018 use of one Standardized HUD Tool eliminated this issue.
13	Exits from PH programs under 90 days	Given that the goal of PSH programs is to build housing stability, programs should not be measured on the # of exits from the program under 90 days.	Do not measure this area in 2018	The HUD performance measure includes successful retention or exit to other permanent housing within the data catchment period (one year) as the measure of success.
14	Coc Funds for Capital	CoC funds would be an important source of "gap financing" if permitted to be used for capital purposes. This was previously allowed in the CoC, but the use has recently been discontinued.	Allow in the 2018 cycle	Use of CoC Annual renewal demand funds for capital expenses would permanently reduce the level of funds available to the CoC because acquisition, rehabilitation and new construction funds are not renewable. To support capital projects, the CoC has moved to providing access to operating and support services funds for capital projects and giving points for new projects that receive the acq-rehab-new construction costs from other resources. Consideration of capital projects for BONUS funding could be explored.
