Date and Time: January 25, 2018/4:00-8:00 am

Time Commitment: Counters commit to a shift of 4 to 5 hours depending on your assignment. Most shifts begin about 15 minutes before WeAllCount's official time.

Location: Engaged Count Site locations vary throughout San Diego County depending on your interest and availability.

Description of Responsibilities:

- Enumerating and surveying homeless individuals sleeping unsheltered during the night of WeAllCount in areas not ordinarily used as a place for human habitation including sidewalks, parks, transit stations, commercial establishments, alleyways, bushes, cars, and hand-built structures.
- View a mandatory "Engaged Count Training Video" prior to your shift. Can be done online, in-person or via webinar.
- Check in the morning of WeAllCount at an assigned Engaged Count Site.
- Work with outreach workers in teams to survey an assigned route within a specific census tract area.
- Submit completed counting materials to Count Site Coordinators at the end of your shift.
- Able to physically move 1 to 2 miles for the count.

Depending on the location you select for the WeAllCount you may need to have access to transportation.
