Greetings 2019 CoC Grant Applicants,

Today, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced FY 2019 Continuum of Care (CoC) Tier 2 grants, including \$1,860,851 for the top project in the San Diego City and County CoC, bringing the total 2019 CoC Competitive funding to \$23,147,314. This amount provides full funding for all renewal projects, five new projects, and one expansion grant.

The newly funded projects are: St. Vincent de Paul Benson Place; The Salvation Army Door of Hope Permanent Supportive Housing; Home Start East County Rapid Rehousing; the Regional Task Force on the Homeless Coordinated Entry for Domestic Violence Safety and Planning Projects; and the expansion of SouthBay Community Services, Casas de Luz.

HUD's awards to the fifty projects will support key housing, essential services, and infrastructure throughout the CoC region. Congratulations to the awardees!

The RTFH will request the scores and debriefing of the FY2019 application from HUD as part of the preparation for the anticipated FY2020 CoC Competition.
