## 2023 Point-in-Time Count Data

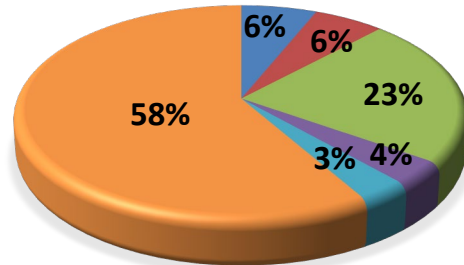
Beginning in 2017, the RTFH began collaborating with the San Diego County Sheriff's Department to survey individuals residing in jail on the night of the count. This year 6 jails participated. On the night of the count, 854 inmates, representing 22% of the total jail population, were asked if they would participate in this year's Point in Time Count Survey. Of those surveyed **32%** or 274 stated they were experiencing unsheltered homelessness the night they were incarcerated.

Identified as Black, African American, or African	23%

% of those surveyed who are Transitional Age Youth (18-24)	4%
% of those surveyed who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces	12%

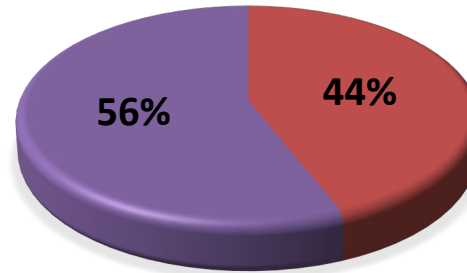

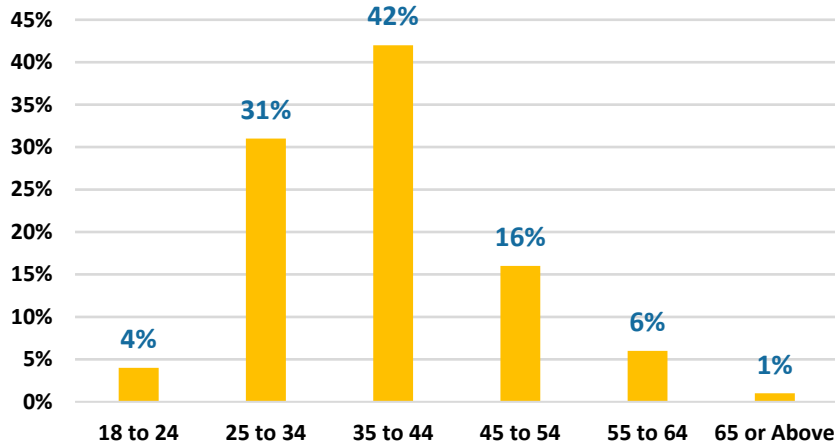

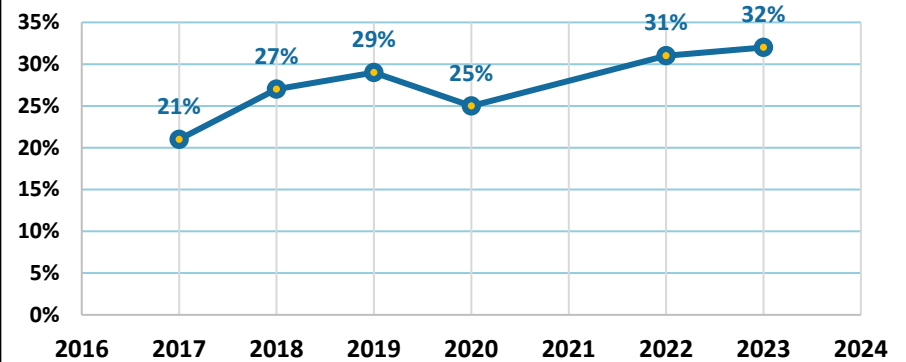

### AGE



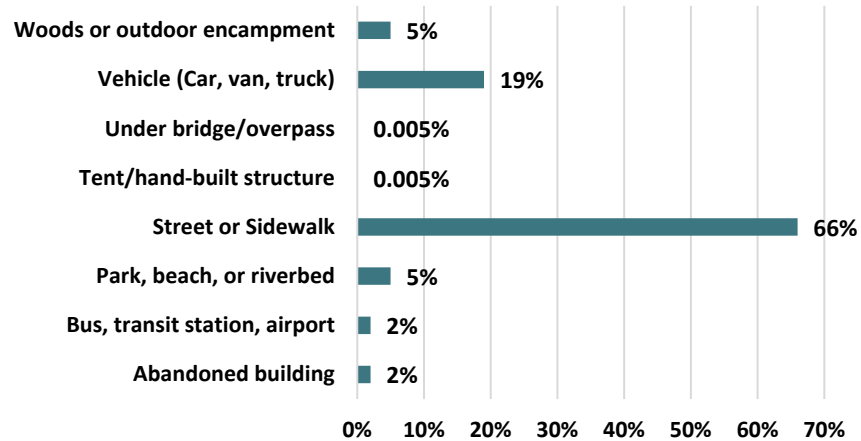
### Percentage of persons incarcerated who were unsheltered on the night of the count 2017-2023



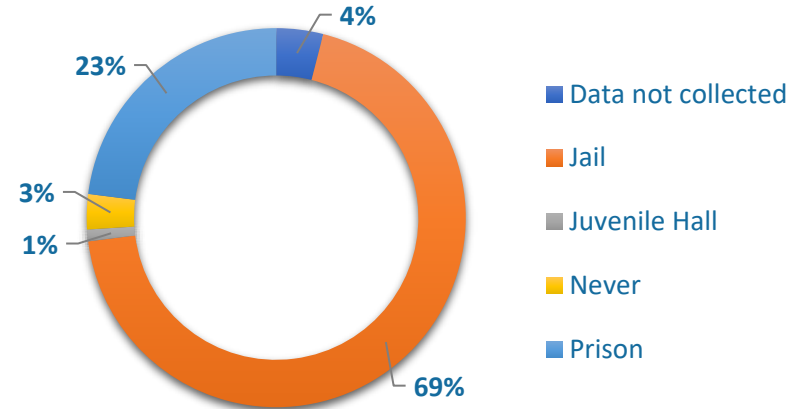
