

Youth Count Data 2023 Point-in-Time Count Data

For the purposes of this data report we collected data on Transitional Aged Youth between the ages of 18 to 24. For the unsheltered count 169 youth were observed and 105 youth were interviewed out of 274 youth who were counted under the 2023 Youth unsheltered Point-in-Time Count. The 2023 Youth unsheltered Point-in-Time Count is conducted over a 1-week period and began on January 26, 2023.
