## Data & Results: Youth

A significant barrier in understanding the national scope and scale of youth homelessness is the lack of historical data available on children and transitional-age-youth experiencing homelessness. The Regional Task Force on the Homeless has worked to emphasize homeless youth as a distinct sub-population of the homeless by conducting a Youth Count separate from the general WeALLCount. The data presented includes unstably housed youth as well to gain a holistic understanding of youth homelessness.

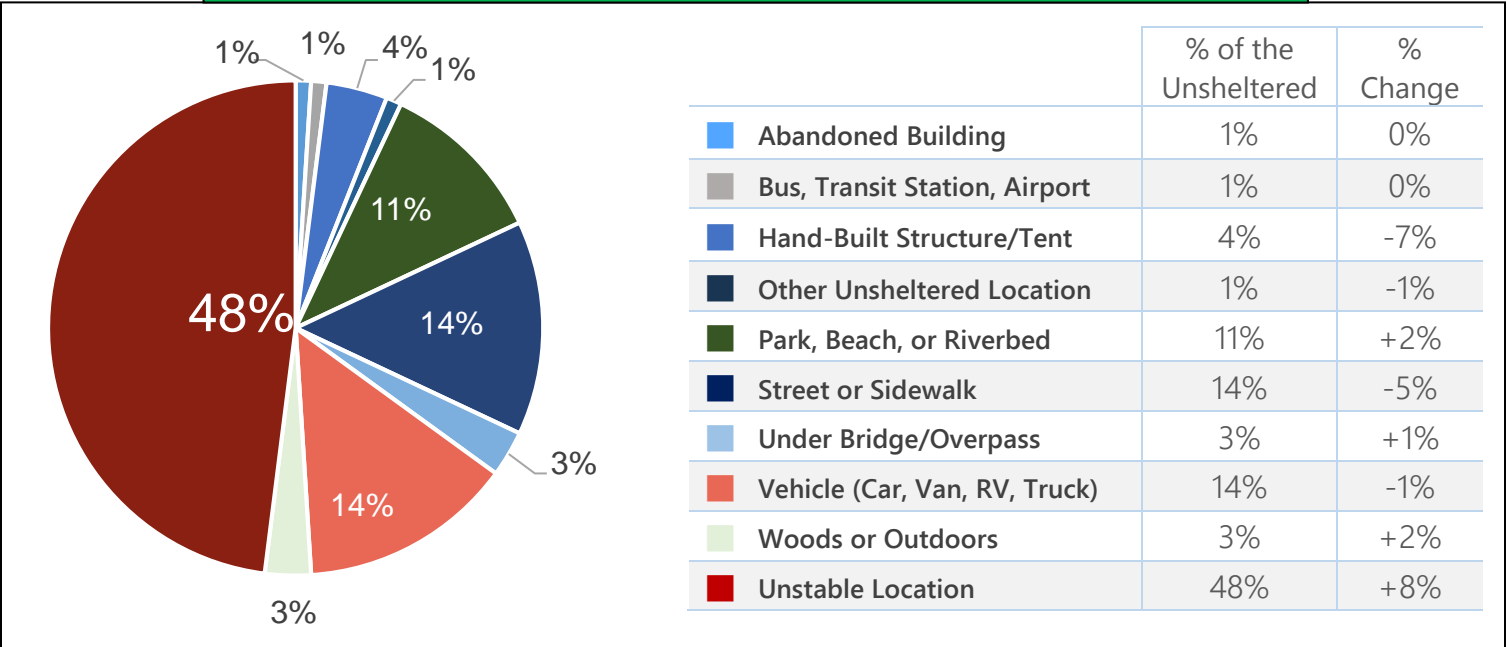

### Homeless Youth Demographics
