STRATEGIC COLLABORATION

Stay informed on regional initiatives and contribute a voice in shaping strategies through stakeholder partnerships.



VOTING RIGHTS

Full Members drive policies that move the region toward the shared goal of ending homelessness.



COMMITTEE PARTICIPATION

CoC Full Members may participate in committee work that informs and influences policies and procedures.



TRAINING & EDUCATION

Access the latest training, learning collaboratives, and best practices for ending homelessness — for all staff levels.



LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY

Stay current on advocacy opportunities and share perspectives on homelessness-related legislative issues.



REGIONAL PLANNING

Be part of the coordinated regional system responsible for reducing and ending homelessness in San Diego.





MEMBERSHIP TYPES & FEES

Membership is open to individuals and organizations. Each organizational member may designate up to three representatives, with one vote per organization. Individual membership is designed for residents, students, educators, consumers, and anyone committed to ending homelessness.

Membership Type	Voting Member 	Non-Voting Member
INDIVIDUAL	\$50 Annual Fee	No Fee
ORGANIZATION	\$100 Annual Fee	No Fee

Fee waivers are available for homeless or formerly homeless individual members, or as approved by the Governance Board.

 **VOTING MEMBERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR EARLY-BIRD DISCOUNTED TICKETS TO RTFH'S ANNUAL CONFERENCE ON HOMELESSNESS.**

FULL MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Commit to the CoC's Mission
- Submit a membership application with annual fee payment
- Abide by Conflict of Interest and Code of Conduct Policies
- Participate in board advisory committees and/or task groups as appropriate
- Renew annual fee payment to keep membership and representatives active
- Voting members must attend at least 2 meetings and an annual meeting
- One vote per full membership (organizations designate one representative to vote)
