

Access Sites serve as a starting point for getting connected to available housing resources. Each one differs in what they can provide to clients. It is recommended that you call ahead to learn more about the options available at the Access Site prior to visiting their physical location. Connecting with an Access Site does not guarantee that you will receive direct assistance with housing or shelter. It is important that you stay in touch with the Access Site regularly by updating your contact information or reporting a major change in your situation.

For the most up to date information, we always encourage calling the Access Site you are trying to attend. These are the updates that have been made available to the RTFH. All information posted here has been shared with 2-1-1 at this time.
