Did you know that, in the United States, **formerly incarcerated individuals are nearly 10 times more likely to experience homelessness** than the general population? And that **people experiencing homelessness are as much as 11 times more likely to face incarceration** compared to the general population?

Recognizing the impact of criminal legal system involvement on the cycle of housing instability, homelessness, and incarceration, the Regional Task Force on Homelessness has partnered with Homebase, a technical assistance provider through HUD, to present an **educational workshop series for all homeless service providers.**
